WAG is a non-profit organization developed to promote the sport of dog agility in the Willamette Valley. Membership in the club is \$20 per year for an individual or \$25 per year for a family. There is a one-time only equipment fee of \$30 for each new individual or family membership. The membership year runs from Jan. 1 to Dec. 30 and the dues are prorated for those joining in the middle of the year. New members must be endorsed by two current members and approved by three-fourths of those voting at the group meeting. All applicants must participate in three club activities, at least one of which must be attendance at a Board of Directors meeting, before acceptance.
