ENTRY RULES: We will accept entries postmarked on **June 2, 2014** or later until the limit is reached or the Closing Date of **July 3, 2014**, whichever comes first. Incomplete or inaccurate forms will NOT be accepted. No hand deliveries or signatures required, please. Spaces in this trial will be allotted in postmark order, not in the order received by the Trial Secretary. If more entries with the opening date postmark are received than the total number of runs available, priority will be given to exhibitors who volunteer to help at the trial. The remaining slots will be drawn from randomly selected entries. If the trial fills on a subsequent date, the drawing will be made from all entries. Any entry that is not accompanied by payment in full will be considered invalid. We have the right to refuse any entry. Anyone who is not currently in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed entry into the trial.

CONFIRMATIONS: Confirmations will be sent via email. If you do not have email, please note on your entry that you would like your confirmation sent by standard mail. Confirmations sent by standard mail may arrive later than those emailed.

PRIZES AND AWARDS: Placement ribbons will be awarded to at least fourth place in each jump height for each class, in each category, except Chances which is a pass/fail class. A purple qualifying ribbon shall be given for each qualifying round in each class. Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 6th place in each jump height in Novice classes.

THE MANAGEMENT will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor, whether the result was by accident or any other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of fees paid will be made.

There is no check-in: Verifying your dog's NADAC registration number is your responsibility. You may pick up your dog's entry toy any time during the day. Please, one toy per dog.

Measurement: The Trial Secretary will contact you if your dog needs to be measured.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

NADAC DOG REGISTRATION NUMBERS: You must register your dog(s) with NADAC before entries will be accepted. Dogs can be registered on-line at the NADAC web site at <http://nadac.com/afirm/dogregfrm.asp>

Below is a brief summary of NADAC rules. Please refer to www.nadac.com for a full explanation of all NADAC rules and up to date information.

- ⤴ Please note that NADAC trials should provide a safe and fun environment for both exhibitors and their dogs. Aggressive dogs will not be tolerated and will be excused from the trial.
- ⤴ The show committee has the right to refuse any entry. Anyone not currently in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed to enter this trial.
- ⤴ Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.
- ⤴ No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- ⤴ Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$25.00 service charge for bank returned checks.
- ⤴ **Dog must be registered and have a valid registration number before entries will be accepted. <http://nadac.com/afirm/dogregfrm.asp>
- ⤴ A copy of the current Exhibitors Handbook may be downloaded free from the NADAC web site: www.nadac.com Exhibitors may request a printed copy of the current Exhibitor Handbook by sending \$5.00 to: *North American Dog Agility Council LLC (NADAC) 24605 Dodds R., Bend, OR 97701.*
- ⤴ 100% of entry fees will be refunded if requested before the closing date. After the closing date, injured or ill handlers or injured, ill or in-heat dogs will receive a refund, less a \$20.00 handling fee (per dog). Verification from a doctor or vet may be requested.
- ⤴ There shall be no refunds for withdrawals requested on or after the first competition date listed in this premium, regardless of the reason.
- ⤴ Running order will be determined at the club's discretion. An attempt will be made to separate runs for handlers with more than one dog in a class.

Non-Jumping Classes—Veteran or Disabled Handler. Handlers who are 60 years or older, or who have a disability that restricts mobility, may choose to enter the non-jumping classes as a Veteran Handler and receive 10% more standard course time. This option is for Veteran/Disabled handlers in the non-jumping classes only. The Veteran/Disabled Handler division is designed for handlers who, due to age or impairment, are mobility limited and need extra time to guide their canine partners through an agility course. When entering as a Veteran/Disabled Handler, you must enter all dogs in all classes for the entire trial in this Division and must jump 4" lower than your Proficient, Standard Division jump height requires. In the non-jumping classes, dogs will be scored and placed with their Standard Division jump height

IMPORTANT. Please check your dog's NADAC registration number on your trial confirmation as soon as you receive it; also, please check the copy of the results posted at the trial. You should report any errors to the Trial Secretary immediately.

NADAC records trial results as they are submitted by the host clubs/groups. The individual trial results submitted by the club are uploaded to the files section of the www.NADACForum.com within two weeks after the NADAC office receives them from the club. Please accept the responsibility to review those results, and check that your registration number and qualifying points, as reported by the club, are correct. You can join the Forum by going to www.NADACForum.com and submitting your request. If you find an error in the reporting of your dog's qualifying points or registration number, please contact the host club. The host club is responsible for correcting any errors and informing NADAC.

Levels. Points earned at a higher level of a class, prior to the completion of the lower level title, will not be banked by NADAC for future use. If a dog earns points in a level of a class that they are not eligible to title in, those points will not be added to the dog's records.

SKILLED AND PROFICIENT CATEGORIES

Dogs must be entered in either the Skilled or the Proficient category. A dog may not be entered in Skilled one day and Proficient on another day. Dogs may enter the Skilled or Proficient category in the Standard, Veteran, or Junior Handler Division.

If you enter the Skilled category, you MUST enter your dog one jump height (4") lower than its Proficient standard jump height. (Four inches will remain the minimum jump height.) Dogs are allotted the standard course time for, and are scored and placed, in the jump height entered.

EQUIPMENT. Rubber matted contact equipment will be used in both rings. The safety/displaceable tire and 24" weavers will also be used.

New Rule as of January-2014: Dogs must enter the Veterans Division in all jumping classes after their 9th birthday. After their 12th birthday, dogs must enter the Skilled Category, Veterans Division for jumping classes and Skilled Category for non-jumping classes

AGREEMENT

The person who signs this agreement represents that he/she is authorized to enter into this agreement on behalf of both exhibitor and the owner of entered dog. In consideration of acceptance of this entry:

- 1.1 As used here NADAC means North American Dog Agility Council, its members, officers, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.
- 1.2 Exhibitor/owner, agree to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.
- 1.3 Exhibitor/owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.
- 1.4 Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including but not limited to, the condition of the fields, floors, stairways, halls, lighting, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fitting, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.
- 1.5 Exhibitor/owner release NADAC (including NADAC officers, employees and members), WAG (including its officers directors, members, and event organizing committee), and the Lincoln County School District (including its officers, agents, and employees) and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, exhibitor/owner hereby specifically assume sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the afore-mentioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequences of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury or death may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.
- 1.6 I (We) acknowledge that by entering this class or event, I am or will be, a Limited Member of the Willamette Agility Group.

In consideration of the acceptance of the entry, I/we certify that I/we have knowledge of, and are familiar with, and agree to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC and WAG in effect at the time of this trial, and by any additional rules and regulations as approved by NADAC and WAG for this trial. I/we certify that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. I/We further agree by our signature on the official entry form of this premium to be bound by this "agreement".

Coming west from Corvallis/Philomath on Hwy 20: After entering Newport, turn right (north) the first traffic light onto Harney St. Go approximately seven blocks and turn right (east) on 7th St. The middle/intermediate school is about four blocks on the left.

Coming south from Lincoln City on Hwy 101: After entering Newport, go through two traffic lights and turn left (east) on 12th St. Go four blocks to Eads St (stop sign) and turn right (south). Go five blocks to 7th St and turn left (east). The middle/intermediate school is about four blocks on the left.

Coming north from Florence/Waldport on Hwy 101: After crossing the Yaquina Bay bridge in Newport, go through one traffic light and turn right at the second traffic light (east) onto Hwy 20 (towards Toledo/Corvallis). Go to the next traffic light and turn left (north) on Harney St. Go approximately seven blocks and turn right (east) on 7th St. The middle/intermediate school is about four blocks on the left.
