Check In: ALL HANDLERS MUST CHECK IN. NADAC has requested that we verify each dog's registration number. To expedite check in, send a copy of your dog's permanent height or registration card with your entry. All dogs not presenting a permanent height card with the entry or at check in must be measured during check in, except those dogs entered at the 20" and 20+". Check in is from 7:00 to 7:30 AM on Saturday and Sunday. **On both days, walk through for the first course is at 7:30 AM and classes begin at 8:00 AM.**

Entry Rules: We will accept entries postmarked on March 20, 2007, or later, until either the maximum number of runs per day is reached or the closing date of April 9, 2007. Spaces in this trial will be allotted in postmark order, not in the order of receipt by the Trial Secretary. If there are more entries than the limit allows then preference will be given to a limited number of volunteers. We have the right to refuse any entry. Anyone who is not currently in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed entry into the trial.

Donation: A percentage of the trial proceeds will be donated to Washington Alaskan Malamute Adoption League (WAMAL).

Move-ups will be accepted until April 23, 2007.

Move-ups will not be accepted at the trial.

Prizes and Awards: Purple rosettes will be awarded for all qualifying runs. Ribbons will be awarded for Novice 1st through 6th place, Open and Elite 1st – 4th place in each jump height and class.

Crating Space: Crating space inside the arena building is limited. No x-pens inside the arena please. Crating in cars may be necessary. Walk throughs will be announced to the parking area.

Food: There will not be a food vendor on site. A hospitality table will be available in the mornings. Various fast food restaurants are located within a few miles of the site.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

This trial is sanctioned by the North American Dog Agility Council (NADAC), with Willamette Agility Group (WAG) as the host club. **Exhibitors, through submission of their entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations and relevant WAG policies, including the following rules regarding entry, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial:**

Dogs must be registered and have a valid registration number before entries will be accepted. Pending numbers are no longer accepted. NADAC registration forms can be obtained at the NADAC website, or dogs can be registered online to immediately receive a permanent registration number. Go to www.nadac.com (click on "Dogs" on the home page).

Current Jump Height Table, Breed Exemption List, description of classes, levels, categories and divisions are included in the current NADAC Exhibitor's Handbook. A copy of the current Exhibitor's Handbook may be downloaded for free from the NADAC website. Or Exhibitors may request a hard copy of the current Exhibitor's Handbook by sending \$5.00 to: North American Dog Agility Council, PO Box 1206, Colbert OK 74733-1206.

- All dogs must be on leash when not competing in the ring unless they are in the exercise field.
- No leads, collars, food, toys, or other aids or devices will be permitted on the course at any time. Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee.
- There will be a \$20.00 service charge for bank returned checks. There will be no refunds in the event that a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for dismissal.
- 100% of entry fees will be refunded if requested prior to the closing date. If you cannot attend please let the Trial Secretary know as soon as possible.

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- Running order will be determined at the club's discretion. An attempt will be made to separate runs for handlers with more than one dog in a class.
- In the Skilled category an exhibitor may choose to enter the dog at the height it would jump in Proficient or one jump height lower.
- Veteran Handlers or Disabled Handlers receive 10% more standard course time in the non-jumping classes.

THE MANAGEMENT will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor, whether the result was by accident or any other cause. It is agreed as a condition of acceptance of this entry that every dog at this event is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of fees paid will be made.

IMPORTANT. Please check your dog's NADAC registration number on your trial confirmation as soon as you receive it; also, please check the copy of the results posted at the trial. You should report any errors to the Trial Secretary immediately.

NADAC no longer hand checks for discrepancies the records we send them at the end of the trial. Instead, they post the trial results to the files section of the NADACAgility@yahoogroups.com list within two weeks after receiving them from us. The trial results will remain on the list for at least thirty (30) days. Please accept the responsibility to review those results, and check that your registration number and qualifying points, as reported by the club, are correct. You can join the NADAC Agility list and set your settings to "no mail". You'll be able to view trial results and find discrepancies (if any) without receiving list mail. Contact NADAC **only** if your registration number or qualifying results are shown incorrectly on the list. Otherwise, you do not need to do anything.

Levels. Points earned at a higher level of a class, prior to the completion of the lower level title, will no longer be banked by NADAC for future use. As of June 1, 2006 if a dog earns points in a level of a class that they are not eligible to title in, those points will not be added to the dog's records.

Starting in Salem, from I-5 (North or South) take Hwy 22 West approx. 10 miles to Hwy 99W (Pacific Hwy). Turn left (South) on Hwy 99W/Pacific Hwy and go approx. 6 miles to Monmouth. Travel 2.6 miles from the signal at Hwy 99 and main in Monmouth. The arena is on the left (East) across from the white fencing.

Coming from the South on 99W, the driveway is just past milepost #66.

Just South of the driveway, on both sides of the road, are "Adopt-A-Highway" signs.

AGREEMENT

The person who signs this agreement represents that he/she is authorized to enter into this agreement on behalf of both exhibitor and the owner of entered dog. In consideration of acceptance of this entry:

1.1 As used here, NADAC means North American Dog Agility Council, its members, officers, employees, show chairs, show committees, and agents.

1.2 Exhibitor/owner agree to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.

1.3 Exhibitor/owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.

1.4 Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including but not limited to, the condition of the floors, stairways, halls, lighting, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fitting, show rings, parking areas, and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.

1.5 Exhibitor/owner release NADAC (including NADAC officers, employees and members), WAG (including its officers, directors, members, and event organizing committee), and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands, and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, exhibitor/owner hereby specifically assume sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequences of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury or death may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.

1.6 I/we acknowledge that by entering this class or event, I am or will be, a Limited Member of Willamette Agility Group.

In consideration of the acceptance of the entry, I/we agree to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC and WAG in effect at the time of this trial, and by any additional rules and regulations as approved by the boards of NADAC and WAG for this trial. **I/we further agree by my signature on page 4 (Official Entry) of this premium to be bound by this "agreement".**
